**MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE ELECTION GENERAL MEETING
HELD ON 8TH OF JULY, 2019 AT 4:00PM FOR GOVERNING BODY
ELECTION FOR THE TERM 2019-2021**

Today General Body Meeting was called from 4 pm onwards with the agenda to declare results of the Governing Body of the Raisina Bengali School Society, New Delhi for the term, 2019-2021 in the Hall of Mandir Marg School. Scrutiny of ballots for this election had completed on 7th of July, 2019 and results were tabulated. Voters in large numbers attended the meeting. The entire proceedings were videographed. Voters were served with tea and biscuits.

In terms of the tabulated no. of ballots prepared separately on a sheet the following candidates were found top 07 (seven) scorers of votes”-

1.	Mr. Chandan Bhattacharya -	1741 votes
2.	Mr. Harish Kumar Poddar -	1469 votes
3.	Mr. Pranab Sasmal -	1442 votes
4.	Mr. Buddhadeb Mukherjee -	1421 votes
5.	Mr. Sukumar Biswas -	1413 votes
6.	Ms. Chitra Maji -	1412 votes
7.	Mr. Chandrajit Mandal -	1410 votes

Accordingly these 07 (seven) candidates were declared elected as "Governing Body Members" of Raisina Bengali School Society, New Delhi for the term 2019-2021.

Panel of 05 candidates in terms of rule 36, read with rule 6 of the Constitution of the Raisina Bengali School Society, has also been prepared which is as under :-

1. Mr. Kripamay Bhattacharya	758 votes
2. Mr. Janmejay Das	756 votes
3. Mr. Ranjan Kumar	754 votes
4. Mr. Subroto Biswas	735 votes
5. Mr. Devmoy	558 votes.

Panel of these 05 (five) candidates was also declared in the General Body.

Further, result of rest of the candidates was also read out in the General Body.

Election of President and Vice-President from amongst 07 members of the Governing Body was then taken up in General Body Mr. Buddhadeb Mukherjee proposed and Mr. Ranajit Samaddar (Member) seconded the name of Mr. Pranab Sasmal for the post of Vice-President which was announced in the General Body and General Body was invited if any other contestant or voter had objection to that name. Nobody raised any objection against name of Mr. Pranab Sasmal for the post of Vice President and Mr. Pranab Sasmal was declared unanimously elected as the Vice-President of the Governing Body of the Society.

Thereafter, election for the post of President was taken up. Mr. Chandrajit Mandal proposed and Mr. Plaban Bhunia (Member) seconded the name of Mr. Sukumar Biswas for the post of President. The same was announced in the General Body and any contest and/or objection to the name of Mr. Sukumar Biswas was invited from the General Body. No objection was raised by anybody and accordingly, Mr. Sukumar Biswas was declared unanimously elected as President of the Governing Body.

With the declaration of results as detailed above, the election proceeding concluded with a VOTE OF THANKS read out by Mr. Chinmay Sarkar and finally a concluding address was made by Justice (Retd.) S.P. Garg, Administrator-cum-observer.


After the results were declared, Mr. Chandan Bhattacharya and Mr. Harish Kumar Poddar appeared in person and both submitted letters/ representations submitting their resignation from the elected candidature of Governing Body. Soon thereafter 09 more similar letters/ representations were submitted and these were from Mr. Devmoy, Mr. Sujit Maity, Mr. Tapan Kumar Gupta, Mr. Samar Chakravarty, Mr. Subrata Kumar Biswas, Mr. Janmejy Das, Mr. Ranjan Kumar, Mr. Subroto Biswas and Mr. Kripamay Bhattacharya. Their letters / representations, exactly verbatim, are taken on record. Since result of the elections


to the Governing Body has already been announced in the General Body, let these letters/ representations be dealt with in accordance with Constitution of the Society.

The Voting Papers/ Ballots as well the envelopes which were collected after the scrutiny of the Voting Papers/ Ballots have been put into two ballot boxes and padlocks were put on those two boxes and keys were taken into custody, along with all Tabulation Reports of the Scrutiny of Voting Papers; by the Returning Officer on the date of counting. i.e., 07.07.2019 and all these Voting Papers/ Ballots and envelopes will be part of the Election Report.


